



## Master of Accountancy Program (MAcc)

We intend to make a temporary masters program available to our current majors in Smeal (juniors and seniors).

We are proposing a new integrated B.S./MAcc program online for next year (2009/2010) that will be a 2/3 program. Under that program, students will apply in the spring of their sophomore year (i.e., after their first two years) and those that are accepted and choose to enroll will complete an integrated program will complete a B.S. and MAcc in the three subsequent years. Once this program is online, the temporary program will be terminated.

We are in the very early stages of considering other MAcc program offerings (e.g., programs for students who already have undergraduate degrees in accounting), but I do not anticipate any such programs will be up and running in the next couple of academic years.
