

## GPA (GRADE POINT AVERAGE) CONVERSION TABLES

Please use the most appropriate scale below to calculate your grade point average for each school you attended. Take the number of credit hours of A's and multiply by 4, multiply the number of credit hours of B's by 3, C's by 2, D's by 1 and F's by 0. Add their sums and divide by the total number of credit hours of A's, B's, C's and D's. etc.

Example: A student has A's for 9 credit hrs, B's for 4 credit hrs and C's for 2 credit hrs  
 Calculation:  $(9 \times 4) + (4 \times 3) + (2 \times 2) = 52$  GPA =  $52 / (9 + 4 + 2) = 3.47$

Refer to the appropriate scale which is suitable for your grading scheme and do the calculation. For Traditional British System (e.g India, Australia), please list the classification of honors and convert as shown in the table with class grades. Please refer to the appropriate class system below.
